No abra la puerta

- > Pídale al agente de ICE que muestre una orden por la ventana o que la pase por debajo de la puerta.
- > Para que un agente de ICE pueda entrar a su casa, ICE tiene que tener una orden judicial que:
 - ✓ Tenga su nombre y dirección correcta
 - ✓ Esté firmada por un juez
- > Si no traen dicha orden, dígale:
 - ✓ "This is not a warrant signed by a judge, you do not have the right to come in."
 - ✓ "I am calling my attorney."

Tiene el derecho de hablar con un abogado/a

- No responda a ninguna pregunta. Diga: "I want to remain silent."
- No diga nada acerca de dónde nació o cómo entró a los Estados Unidos.
- Siga insistiendo con que necesita hablar con su abogado/a "I need to speak to my attorney."

NO firme nada que usted no entienda

FOR WARRANT FOR
ENTRY ON PREMISES TO
SEARCH FOR ALIENS
WHO ARE IN THE UNITED
STATES WITHOUT LEGAL
AUTHORITY

The United States of America, having filed an application to authorize officers of United States Immigration and Customs without legal authority and, if any such persons are found on the premises, to exercise their authority pursuant to section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1357, to question them to determine whether they are such aliens and, if there is probable cause to believe they are such aliens, to arrest them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement shall conduct the entry and search during daylight hours with ten (10) days of the issuance of this warrant, and make its return to this Court with ten (10) days of the date the entry and search have been completed.
